Accompanying persons program

MONDAY 8 MAY (FULL DAY)

Guided tour with professional English-speaking guide in the fascinating centre of Alghero, rich in history, culture and incredible buildings and monuments, among which the bastions and the church and cloister of San Francesco (Saint Francis). Lunch at Porto Conte Ricerche with the participants of the symposium and then the tour continues with a guided visit of the Neptune's caves, to the discovery of an unbelievable natural work of art. These caves are among the most famous in Sardinia and certainly the largest: they extend for about 4 km, but for safety reasons visitors can access them only partially.





TUESDAY 9 MAY (HALF DAY)

Morning program starting with a guided visit of the fantastic necropolis of Anghelu Ruju, the largest necropolis of pre-Nuragic Sardinia. After that the group will visit the extraordinary Nuraghe Palmavera, classified as a complex nuraghe and consisting of several towers joined together. The nuraghe and the surrounding village were built in various phase during the Bronze Age and the Iron Age. The tour will continue with a stop for panoramic pictures at the Capocaccia promontory, an incredible place enjoying a breath-taking view. The tour will terminate at the Porto Conte Ricerche for lunch with the rest of the group.





WEDNESDAY 10 MAY (HALF DAY)

Morning transfer to the nearby city of Sassari, always accompanied by a professional English-speaking guide. Here the group will visit the historic centre of the city, the cathedral and the National Archaeological Museum. On the way back to Alghero, stop for guided tour and wine tasting at the excellent Poderi Parpinello. After this interesting visit, transfer to Porto Conte Ricerche (followed by departure for the post-conference tour for those who subscribed to it).
